

Privacy Policy

UCS may change our privacy from time to time. UCS urges you to check for any updates.

United Consumer Services (UCS) believes that client privacy is a top priority. UCS is dedicated to keeping our clients informed about the ways we will use their personal information and the steps taken to protect it. To better serve you please take a moment to review this privacy policy, it describes the steps UCS will make to protect your personal information.

United Consumer Services (UCS) provides an alternative to Bankruptcy, known as debt settlement. This service helps consumers to eliminate their personal unsecured debts by negotiating the balances with their creditors. UCS also helps consumers by referring them to outside companies that may be able to better service their financial needs. Examples of affiliates consist of mortgage companies, bankruptcy attorneys, debt counselors, and other providers of financial services.

In this Privacy Policy the terms “we,” “our,” and “us” refer to United Consumer Services

This privacy policy pertains to all visitors to our Unitedconsumerservices.com website and any other web pages which UCS may host. It applies to any information given to us by consumers who communicate with us about our products or services. It also applies to any information given to us by clients who obtain or use any of our products or services.

The information UCS collects falls into two categories.

The first category of information gathered is personal contact information, such as your name, address, phone number, IP address, and email address. UCS will gather this information to contact individuals who make inquiries to UCS about our services. This information will be used for the purpose of opening client files and accounts for those who utilize the services we provide. This information may be shared for the purposes of marketing to third party financial services companies when authorized. By submitting contact information online, any visitor authorizes UCS to share that contact information with other financial service providers. UCS may also share or sell your contact information with companies that have products or services UCS thinks might interest you. You may contact us to opt out of such contact. UCS will honor any such request we receive from you, and UCS will require the companies that work with us to maintain policies and notices that are similar to this one.

The second type of information is nonpublic personal information. This is confidential client information that UCS will collect and use to provide services to our clients. It is kept in a secure database.

All the information UCS collects is given to us with the consent of the person who provides the information.

UCS will use your personal information to provide you with service, and to communicate with you regarding the activities in your file. In addition, you authorize UCS to keep you up to date on service announcements, client updates about our services, special offers, and other information we think you would like to hear about. From time to time, UCS may also use your personal information to contact you about participating in opinion surveys. These help us measure client satisfaction and improve our service further.

If you inquire about the types of products or services UCS provides, one of our employees or representatives will contact you. Thereafter, UCS may occasionally contact you about a product or service that UCS thinks might interest you. UCS does not disclose specific financial information, such as account numbers or balances, to anyone for marketing purposes. Specific financial information is only used to provide the products or services you request from us. This information may be shared with affiliated third parties UCS employs to assist with providing these services.

Who Collects Information from UCS

Typically, UCS will begin to collect personal contact information when you make an inquiry on the internet about the kind of services we offer. If you made your original inquiry about the kinds of services UCS offers to a web page hosted by someone other than UCS, then the privacy policy of that company will control how they use your information. This policy controls the use of information by UCS. UCS urges you to review the privacy policy of any web site that you give personal information.
